### QUESTIONNAIRE ON CAMPS

1. **Name of the camp:**

Ghetto.

2. **Location of the camp:**

Side streets on the east and west side of the city.

3. **Size of the camp:**

10 restricted streets.

4. **Date of establishment of the camp:**

7 July 1942.

5. **Date of closure of the camp:**

8 November 1942.

6. **Were the prisoners only Poles, only Jews from Poland, or Poles and Jews from Poland?**

Only Jews.

7. **Were there any foreigners in the camp? Of what nationality? Were there any Jews from abroad? How many?**

From Austria and Germany.

8. **What was the average number of prisoners in the camp?**

About 7000.

9. **What is the total number of prisoners who passed through the camp while it operated?**

Up to 8000.

**10. What happened with the prisoners upon liquidation of the camp?**

They were displaced and some of them were shot dead during the transport.

**11. Did the prisoners work in the camp (type of work performed, types of workshops)?**

About 200 people were permanently employed in a company called Oemler, where they built roads.

**12. Did the prisoners work outside the camp? What did they do and where?**

They worked on the Chmielnik–Sandomierz road.

**13. What food did the prisoners receive?**

Not enough; they also fed on their own supplies.

**14. Was there an infirmary or a hospital in the camp?**

Yes.

**15. Were there any epidemics in the camp (if yes, what kind)?**

Typhus and typhoid fever.

**16. Are any data on the death rate in the camp available?**

Isolated cases.

**17. Were there any executions in or outside the camp? How was it done?**

There were cases of executions by shooting.

**18. Were the corpses destroyed? How and where?**

They were buried at the local Jewish cemetery.

**19. Was there a crematorium in the camp?**

No.

**20. Was the burial site of the murdered and dead victims determined? (Please indicate the location.)**

A mass grave with about 450 people shot dead during a displacement operation and another one with groups of 10 to 30 people are located at the Jewish cemetery in Staszów.

21. **Current condition of the camp – what was destroyed; what is located on the site of the camp?**

The emptied apartments in the ghetto were occupied by their previous owners and all the traces were covered.

22. **Has any material evidence survived from the camp (documents, items belonging to people who got murdered, etc.)? (Type, place of storage, has it been secured?)**

There is nothing left.

23. **Do you know the surnames or addresses of people who were kept in the camp? (If yes, please provide them.)**

No data due to the destruction of books and registers of the residents.

24. **Do you know the names of the Germans, the head of the camp, or other functionaries? (Please provide their names and ranks.)**

Unknown.

On 5 October 1945, the contents of the above questionnaire were officially certified by the mayor of the city of Staszów, Andrzej Ścisło, with the Municipal Court in Staszów.
